



CALL FOR NGOs PARTNERSHIP PROPOSALS

Rand Water Foundation is a vehicle through which Rand Water fulfills its commitment to helping Government in achieving its vision of a better life for all, by promoting job creation, skills transfer, enterprise development, community capacity building, and poverty eradication among communities. The Foundation is mandated to: promote and support the delivery of water related services to communities in the areas falling within and outside Rand Water's area of supply; coordinate, administer and manage Rand Water's Corporate Social Investment resources by undertaking community development projects in partnership with various donors and relevant stakeholders.

Health including HIV and AIDS is one of the programmes implementing the strategy of the Rand Water Foundation. Service delivery partnerships are required for the following projects:

- Community Home Based Care.
- School Based Health Awareness Raising Project.

The Foundation herewith invites NGOs/Service Providers to submit proposals to partner with the RWF in rendering Health Including HIV and AIDS development partnership services as outlined below:

A. RPL ON COMMUNITY HEALTH WORK- NQF LEVEL 2 - QUALIFICATION ID: 64749- (140 CREDITS)

The successful applicant will be responsible for the following activities:

Educating and training of forty (40) local community members as health care givers, empowering them with basic nursing and care giving skills.

Project Deliverables:

The training should cover the following health unit standard components:

- Conduct (RPL) Interviews and submit the report
- Uploading of Learners
- Training
- Mentoring
- Verification and Certification
- Submit progress report upon completion of each summative close out report, upon overall project completion.

Applications are invited from Free-State and Mpumalanga Provinces. Successful applicants will be responsible for twenty (20) trainees each. The application should indicate operational area of interest.

Applications should be accompanied by the following:

- Detailed Proposal
- Valid registration certificates OR proof of registration
- Proof of previous RPL activities
- Constitution of the organisation if applicable
- Accreditation with the Health and Welfare Seta
- Alignment with the Department of Health requirement and standards
- At least 3 years' experience in the training industry
- Knowledge and understanding of the NGOs sector

B. Orphaned and Vulnerable Children and Child Headed Support Household:

The Project Objectives are:

- To improve the quality of life of the orphaned and vulnerable children and Child Headed Household
- To provide psychosocial support to orphaned and vulnerable children and Child - Headed through the following interventions:

The following are the expected project deliverables:

- **Food and Nutrition Support** – The field workers ensures that the OVCs have food suppliers through the school feeding scheme and the food bank initiative.
- **Shelter and Care** – Ensure that children have shelter and material needs such clothes.
- **Education** – The children are enrolled or re-integrated in schools and are assisted to cope with school work.
- **Financial Support** - Ensuring that the OVC receives the social grant according to their age.
- **Health Care** – Ensure that children received primary health according to their age, such as immunization, treatment for children when they are sick, ongoing treatment for HIV positive children, and HIV prevention.
- **Protection** – Ensure that children’s environment is safe and secure.

Application Requirements:

The following documentation should be attached to the proposals:

- Constitution of the organisation
- Valid NGO registration certificate OR proof of registration
- Tax Clearance Certificate
- Detail Project plan
- Stamped bank letter confirming the account details in the name of the organisation.

- Management account(Income and expenditure statement
- Must be in operation at least for a year
- Complete RWF application Form
