



## **CALL FOR NGOs PARTNERSHIP PROPOSALS**

Rand Water Foundation is a vehicle through which Rand Water fulfills its commitment to helping Government in achieving its vision of a better life for all, by promoting job creation, skills transfer, enterprise development, community capacity building, and poverty eradication among communities. The Foundation is mandated to: promote and support the delivery of water related services to communities in the areas falling within Rand Water's area of supply; coordinate, administer and manage Rand Water's Corporate Social Investment resources by undertaking community development projects in partnership with various donors and relevant stakeholders.

The Women Health Care Support project is one of the projects implementing Women, Youth and Children Programme, one of the seven key focus areas of the Rand Water Foundation strategy. The project is aimed at promoting healthy lifestyle among women, focusing on cancer and other related diseases interventions. The project main focus is screening, clinical breast examination and educational talks on breast and cervical cancer. The project also conducts mammography to women above the age of 40 years.

**Rand Water Foundation herewith invites Qualifying NGOs to apply to become service delivery partner of the Foundation as follows:-**

### **Project Deliverables:**

Successful application will be expected to undertake the following activities:

- To conduct education and awareness on breast, and cervical cancer;
- To provide screening, clinical breast examination to women of all ages;
- To conduct pap smear examination to a total of 800 (eight hundred) women;

- To provide mammograms to 200 (two hundred) women above 40 years of age.

The service will target the following areas within Gauteng Province:

- Diepsloot Community Clinic, City of Johannesburg;
- Orange Farm Community Clinic (Johannesburg);
- Thembisa Clinic, Ekurhuleni;
- Thokoza Community Clinics (Ekurhuleni);
- Pretoria Station (Tshwane).

Applications should meet the following criteria/requirements:

- Detailed Proposal;
- Valid registration certificates OR proof of registration with the nursing profession;
- Proof of previous activities of such nature;
- Constitution of the organisation if applicable;
- Alignment with the Department of Health requirements and standards.

The following documentation should be attached to the proposals:

- Constitution of the organisation;
- Valid NGO registration certificate OR proof of registration;
- Tax Clearance Certificate;
- Detail Project plan;
- Stamped bank letter confirming the account details in the name of the organisation;
- Management account( Income and expenditure statement;
- Must be in operation at least for a year;
- Completed RWF application Form.
